














KS2 Data 2017

The results of the SATs are converted to a scaled score ranging from 80-120. Pupils achieving a scaled score of 100 or more are said to be working at the expected standard. Pupils achieving 110+ are those working at the higher standard.

**These test results are based on a cohort of 18 pupils and therefore each child represents 5.5%. It is therefore important to be mindful of this information when interpreting the data.*
