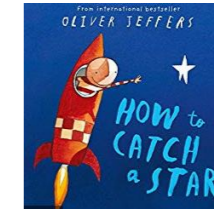
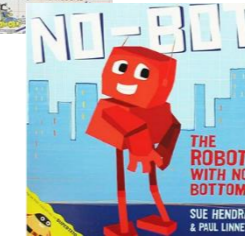
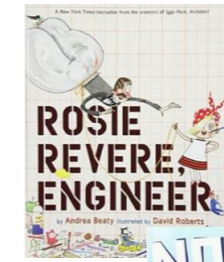
Non-Chronological report writing.
